



**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR A
CONTINUANCE OF THE SCHEDULED HEARING**

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, Penelec Rate District (Respondent or Company), by and through its attorneys, Reger Rizzo & Darnall LLP, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, respectfully requests that the Honorable Steven K. Haas (Judge Haas) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) grant its Motion for Continuance (Motion) and issue an order continuing the scheduled Call-in Telephonic Hearing for December 22, 2025 (Hearing) as the Company’s fact witness, Charles Howlett, is unavailable for the Hearing.

In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

1. On October 15, 2025, Laura Schau (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint seeking, *inter alia*, a Commission payment arrangement (PAR) for service in her name to 142 Broad Avenue, Susquehanna, Pennsylvania (Service Location) under Account No. 100156733469 (Account).

2. On November 4, 2025, the Company filed an Answer denying that the Complainant is eligible for a Commission payment arrangement as the Complainant is actively enrolled in the Company's Pennsylvania Customer Assistance Program (PCAP). The past due balance owed by the Complainant on the Account consists of PCAP arrears. As such, the Company avers that the Commission does not have authority to order a payment arrangement on CAP arrearages.¹

3. By Notice, dated November 5, 2025, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for Monday, December 22, 2025, before Judge Haas.

4. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 (b) states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.

5. The unavailability of the Company's fact witness, Charles Howlett, constitutes good cause consistent with Commission regulation.

6. On December 9, 2025, the office of undersigning Counsel attempted unsuccessfully to reach the Complainant *via* telephone to notify her of the Company's need for a continuance of the scheduled hearing. The Complainant did not pick up, and her voicemail box



not been setup. The office of undersigning Counsel followed up by email to which Complainant timely responded to advise that she opposed the Company's requested continuance.

7. The Company respectfully requests the Call-in Telephonic Hearing be rescheduled for a date after December 22, 2025.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec Rate District) requests that the Honorable Steven K. Haas grant its Motion for Continuance of the scheduled December 22, 2025, Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing.
