Re: Tolling of Amendment Six to the Contract between PPL Electric Utilities Corporation and CLEAResult Consulting Inc. for the implementation of the Residential Program under PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's Phase IV Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan, filed with the Commission on November 25, 2025, at Docket No. M-2020-3020824

Dear Mr. Ryan:

This letter acknowledges that Commission staff has reviewed Amendment Six to an existing Act 129 Conservation Service Provider ("CSP") Contract between PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL") and CLEAResult Consulting, Inc. ("CLEAResult"), filed with the Commission on November 25, 2025, to implement changes to Agreement No. 09048090 (Parent Contract 2313 with P.O. 105933 & P.O. 106537). With this Letter, Commission staff tolls the 45-day deadline to review CSP Contracts and requests a response to a data request.

The *Phase IV Implementation Order*,<sup>1</sup> *inter alia*, required all Electric Distribution Companies subject to Act 129 to submit, for Commission review, all proposed contract amendments with a CSP. (*Phase IV Implementation Order*, Section G, pages 114-117). The Commission must review, and may order the modification of, these proposed contract amendments. 66 Pa. C.S. § 2806.1(a)(8).

PPL is advised that the above-referenced CSP Contract Amendment is not approved at this time, for the reasons set forth below. Commission staff tolls the 45-day deadline and requests a response to the attached data request, to facilitate the review of the CSP Contract Amendment. Once the response to the data request is received, Commission staff will finalize review of the CSP Contract Amendment.
