MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” OR “PUC”) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement-Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That SUPER CAB, INC. Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at PO BOX 60461, Harrisburg, PA 17106.
2. The on March 21, 1976, Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission authorizing transportation, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in call or demand service and paratransit authority, at Application Docket No.A-00099450, PUC Utility Code 638064.
3. That on March 12, 2025, PUC Motor Carrier Enforcement Supervisor Timothy Troxell was assigned an annual taxi inspection of Respondent. On August 7, 2025, Supervisor Troxell spoke with company owner James Halkias, who informed Supervisor Troxell that he wished to abandon Respondent’s taxi authority. Supervisor Troxell sent an application for abandonment via email on August 7, 2025, and again August 20, 2025. The application to abandon or discontinue operations was not returned to Supervisor Troxell or e-Filed with the Commission.
4. That Respondent, by failing to file an application with this Commission prior to abandoning or discontinuing service, violated 52 Pa. Code §1102)a)(2); 52 Pa. Code §3.3819(a)(1)(v). The penalty for this violation is cancellation of the certificate held by Respondent for taxi authority with this Commission at PUC Utility Code 638064.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to SUPER CAB, INC, for taxi authority at PUC Utility Code 638064.
