MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission or “PUC”) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement -Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That DURALITE SALES LLC, Respondent, maintains a principal place of business at 224 Old Forge Drive, Bath, PA 18014 and a mailing address of PO Box 201, Bath, PA 18014.
2. That on February 20, 2025, by Commission Secretarial Letter, Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission authorizing transportation, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania. at Application Docket No. a-2025-3053420, PUC Utility Code 8927578.
3. That PUC Motor Carrier Enforcement Officer Fryslin was assigned to conduct a Safety Fitness Review (“SFR”) and initiated a series of attempts to contact Respondent, to which Officer Fryslin received no response. On September 17, 2025, a letter was mailed to Respondent urging compliance with the 180-day requirement in receiving a satisfactory SFR rating.
4. That on September 26, 2025, Officer Fryslin was contacted by Tammi Porvanik regarding the September 17, 2025, letter concerning scheduling. Ms. Porvanik maintained that the Respondent no longer owns or operates trucks to transport property.
5. That on or about September 29, 2025, Officer Fryslin determined that the Respondent no longer required PUC authority and relayed this information to Ms. Porvanik. Officer Fryslin advised Ms. Porvanik to submit an application to discontinue Respondent’s authority with the PUC and provided the application.
6. That on or about October 6, 2025, Officer Fryslin contacted Ms. Porvanik to confirm if the application was submitted to the PUC. Ms. Porvanik expressed intent to return the executed application promptly. The application has not been received.
7. That Respondent, by failing to submit a letter to the Commission containing a statement that service is no longer being rendered or that the contract has expired, violated 52 Pa. Code §3.381(a)(5). The penalty for this violation is cancellation of the certificate held by Respondent with this Commission at PUC Utility Code 8927578.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to DURALITE SALES LLC, at PUC Utility Code 8927578.
