Dear Ms. Savage:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company's proposed Supplement No. 30 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 submitted on December 1, 2025, to become effective on January 1, 2026. In the filing, the company is proposing to set its TCJA rates to 0.00%.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) Voluntary Surcharge rates are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The TCJA Voluntary Surcharge is subject to reconciliation and Commission review. The TCJA Voluntary Surcharge will remain in place until the Company files and the Commission approves new base rates for the utility pursuant to Section 1308(d) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1308(d).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2025-3058955.
