Dear Ms. Klock:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's proposed Supplement No. 405 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 and the supporting rate computations submitted on November 26, 2025 to become effective on January 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) Temporary Surcharge rate for the twelve-month period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The TCJA Temporary Surcharge is subject to reconciliation and Commission review. The TCJA Temporary Surcharge will remain in place until the Company files and the Commission approves new base rates for the utility pursuant to Section 1308(d) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1308(d).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2025-3058879.
