Dear Ms. Hillery:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation's Customer Education Charge (CEC) supporting rate computations submitted on November 24, 2025 to become effective on January 1, 2026. In the filing, the Company is not proposing to revise its currently effective CEC rate of \$0.0000/Mcf; therefore, no tariff supplement is included with the filing.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed CEC rate for the twelve-month period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to remain effective as filed.

The CEC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
