





**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF
PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE MARTA GUHL:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or “Company”) hereby files this Motion for a Continuance pursuant to Section 5.103 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.103, and requests that the evidentiary hearing scheduled for December 18, 2025, in the above-captioned Complaint proceeding be continued.

Good cause exists to grant a continuance in this matter because PPL Electric requires additional time to continue investigating the complex issues raised in the Formal Complaint, as well as to evaluate and develop settlement offers.

In support of the Motion for Continuance, PPL Electric avers as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. PPL Electric furnishes electric service to approximately 1.4 million customers throughout its certificated service territory, which includes all or portions of twenty-nine counties and encompasses approximately 10,000 square miles in eastern and central Pennsylvania. PPL

Electric is a “public utility” and an “electric distribution company” as defined in Sections 102 and 2803 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 102, 2803.

2. On July 24, 2025, PPL Electric was electronically served with the above-captioned Formal Complaint. The Complaint raised averments related to service reliability and safety concerns.

3. On August 13, 2025, PPL Electric filed an Answer and New Matter to the Complaint.

4. Also on August 13, 2025, PPL Electric filed a Preliminary Objection to the Complaint for failure to conform, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.101(a)(2).

5. On October 22, 2025, Your Honor issued an Interim Order on Preliminary Objections (“Interim Order”), granting PPL Electric’s Preliminary Objection in part, such that the Complainant’s requested relief for monetary damages was stricken. *See* October 22, 2025 Interim Order, Ordering Paragraph 1.

6. On October 29, 2025, Your Honor issued a Prehearing Order for Telephone Hearing, ordering that the initial telephonic hearing in the above-captioned proceeding be held on Thursday, December 18, 2025 at 1:00 PM.

II. REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE

1. PPL Electric respectfully requests a continuance of the evidentiary hearing because the Company requires additional time to continue investigating the complex issues raised by the Complainant’s reliability-related allegations and safety-related claims. In addition, the Company requires additional time to evaluate and develop potential settlement offers for the Complainant.

2. Section 1.15(b) of the Commission’s regulations states:

(b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, requests for continuance of hearings or for extension of time in which to perform an act required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time

by this title or by order of the Commission or the presiding officer, shall be by motion in writing, timely filed with the Commission, stating the facts on which the application rests, except that during the course of a proceeding, the requests may be made by oral motion in the hearing before the Commission or the presiding officer. Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be considered. The requests for a continuance should be filed at least 5 days prior to the hearing date.

52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).

3. In addition, the Prehearing Order issued on October 29, 2025, provides the following:

You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. Continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuance, you must submit a written request (a “motion”) at least five (5) days before the hearing. Your motion should be served pursuant to paragraph 5B below. Your motion should include: (1) The case name, number, and hearing date; (2) The reason you are requesting a continuance; and (3) State whether the other party(s) agrees (or if you do not know). If you do not know whether the other party(ies) agrees to the request, state that you do not know.

Prehearing Order, p. 3 (Oct. 29, 2025).

4. Good cause exists to grant a continuance in this matter because the Company requires additional time to develop its investigation into the issues raised by the Complainants.

5. The Company’s ability to present a defense to the Complainant’s claims would be significantly hindered if the hearing were held on the scheduled date, due to a need to continue investigating the averments.

6. The Company notes that this is its first request for a continuance in this matter, and that the Complainants will not be prejudiced if this Motion is granted.

7. Thus, good cause exists to continue the hearing.

8. Counsel for PPL Electric has reached out to the Complainants regarding the Company’s need to reschedule the hearing in an attempt to (1) ascertain whether the Complainants


would be amenable to the Company's Motion for Continuance and (2) if the Complainants are amenable, to agree on a range of dates that would be acceptable to both parties on which to reschedule the hearing.

9. For these reasons, PPL Electric respectfully requests a continuance of the hearing.

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that a continuance of the hearing be granted in the above-captioned proceeding.
