
Dear Parties:

On December 5, 2025, Frontier Communications of Pennsylvania, Inc. (Frontier) filed a Letter Request for a 20-day extension to file a response to Ms. Reyburn's Formal Complaint. Frontier's Letter Request states that Frontier had filed a Certificate of Satisfaction on November 25, 2025, and then, on December 5, 2025, Frontier received an Objection to the Certificate of Satisfaction from Ms. Reyburn. Frontier further stated in its Letter Request that the parties were actively seeking a non-adjudicative resolution to the case and that, in order to facilitate the pending settlement discussions, an extension was necessary. Finally, it is also important to note that Frontier represents that Ms. Reyburn does not object to the extension.

Frontier is granted an extension of time to file a responsive pleading to the above captioned Formal Complaint.

Frontier's Answer and any other responsive pleadings are due to be filed with the Commission by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on December 29, 2025.<sup>1</sup>
