Re: Verizon Pennsylvania LLC's 2026 PCO Filing - Supplemental

Dear Secretary Homsher:

On October 31, 2025, Verizon Pennsylvania LLC ("Verizon PA") submitted its 2026 Price Change Opportunity ("PCO") filing, stating that it would increase rates for noncompetitive services for both Residential and Business Dial Tone Lines effective January 1, 2026.

This letter is to advise the Commission that Verizon PA is postponing the effective date of the residential increases to March 1, 2026 (it was originally January 1, 2026). The business increases will continue to take effect on January 1, 2026, per the original filing. Verizon PA provides the following tariff sheets changing the effective date of the residential rate increases:


