**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY
FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) by and through its attorney, Timothy K. McHugh, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for December 23, 2025. In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On or about October 20, 2025, Destiny Hoffman (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regarding 631 Milestone Lane, McConnellsburg, Pennsylvania 17233 (“Service Location”) under Account No. 100097425977 (“Account”).

2. On November 10, 2025, the Company filed its Answer denying the material allegations.

3. On November 13, 2025, Administrative Law Judge Steven K. Haas (“ALJ Haas”) issued a Prehearing Order setting an initial telephonic hearing date of December 23, 2025.

4. The Company's primary witness is not available on December 23, 2025 and no alternative witnesses are available.

5. On December 10, and 11, 2025, the undersigned counsel attempted unsuccessfully to reach the Complainant via telephone to notify her of the Company's need for a continuance of hearing. Voicemail messages were left, followed by emails. At the time of this filing, the Complainant has not responded with her position on the requested continuance.

6. As such, the Company respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for December 23, 2025, in this matter be continued to a later date given the unavailability of the Company's primary witness.

II. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE


7. The Commission's regulations permit a request for continuance of a hearing upon good cause shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).
