**INTERIM ORDER
SUSPENDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND
SETTING PROCEDURE FOR SETTLEMENT**

On November 19, 2025, counsel for American Water Works Co., Inc. and Pennsylvania-American Water Co. (PAWC) informed the undersigned via e-mail that the parties were engaged in active settlement negotiations and requested that the first day of hearings on November 20, 2025 be cancelled to allow for additional time to potentially reach a settlement. Based on the parties' mutual agreements to waive cross-examination of most witnesses and their representation that one day would be sufficient for hearings, I granted their request and had notice issued to cancel the hearing on November 20, 2025.

Later on November 19, 2025, counsel for PAWC advised that all parties had reached an agreement in principle to settle all issues in this matter.

On November 21, 2025, the evidentiary hearing in the above-captioned matter was convened for the parties to present their testimony and seek to have it entered into the record through their mutual agreements and with the verifications of the sponsoring witnesses. All pre-served testimony and exhibits were identified in the parties' respective hearing exhibits and

admitted into the evidentiary record, accompanied by the verifications of the sponsoring witnesses.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED.

1. That the briefing schedule set forth in the September 5, 2025 Scheduling Order is suspended.
2. That on or before December 23, 2025, the parties shall file a joint petition for settlement that is executed by representatives of all parties to be bound thereby.
3. That the joint petition for settlement shall include proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.
4. That each party to the joint petition for settlement shall file and serve a statement in support of the settlement on or before December 23, 2025.
5. That statements in support shall utilize a common outline. Every party need not address every issue but should use the same headings.
6. Statements in support should be specific and explain the benefit of the settlement terms to that party, beyond the savings of litigation time and expense. It is strongly recommended that the statements in support address the testimony received at the public input hearings.
7. That the parties are directed to email the settlement filings to the undersigned in PDF and Word format on the date of filing.
