The Bureau of Audits has reviewed FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company's proposed Supplement No. 32 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 submitted on December 10, 2025, to become effective on January 1, 2026. In the filing, the Company is not proposing to revise its currently effective Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) rates of 0.00%.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed DSIC rates for the three-month period of January 1, 2026 through March 31, 2026 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2025-3059183.
