**PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF DENIAL OF APPLICATION FOR
OPERATING AUTHORITY TO TRANSPORT HOUSEHOLD GOODS IN-USE**

Petitioner Drew Moves, LLC t/a Drew Moves (“Drew Moves”) hereby petitions for reconsideration of the denial of its application for operating authority by the Bureau of Technical Utility Services and states as follows:

1. Petitioner is Drew Moves, LLC, which is owned by its sole member, Andrew Zeffiro.¹ Drew Moves submitted a *pro se* application for authority to operate as a motor common carrier of household goods in use on October 29, 2025.² (**Exhibit A**).

2. On November 26, 2025, the Secretary issued a letter denying the application. (**Exhibit B**). This occurred before the application was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

3. Mr. Zeffiro has a degree in Corporate Communications from Robert Morris University. He worked in the household goods moving industry since 2005, starting at Gardner Moving in Pittsburgh from 2005-2011. He then moved to North Carolina and worked for multiple moving companies there. In 2016, took a job with Miracle Movers (“Miracle”) in Wilmington, North Carolina. He worked for Miracle until 2018, including opening a new

While the Bureau of Technical Utility Services did not raise any issues with his financial statement, two factors should be noted: 1) Drew Moves has not drawn on its \$15,000 line of credit, and it is not a liability as such; and 2) Mr. Zeffiro has approximately \$43,000 in personal savings and investments that he is prepared to invest in the business if necessary.

location in Charlotte, North Carolina, leaving only to relocate back to Pittsburgh for personal reasons.

4. In 2019, Miracle's owner Chris Wilhoit approached Mr. Zeffiro with a proposal to open a new Miracle branch location in Pittsburgh. The company obtained operating authority at A-8922412 on or about October 9, 2019, with its application for authority listing Mr. Wilhoit's wife, Samantha Wilhoit, as the sole Member of the company. (**Exhibit C**). While Mr. Zeffiro's job title was Managing Partner, he was really a glorified employee. He had no legal ownership interest. He was promised profit sharing bonuses, but these failed to materialize on all but a few occasions.

5. Unfortunately, as detailed below, Miracle went into a downward spiral for reasons largely outside of Mr. Zeffiro's control. This resulted in multiple operational and compliance deficiencies that are described in the Secretary's denial letter.

6. Starting in 2022, Miracle became financially unstable. It appeared to Mr. Zeffiro that Mr. Wilhoit was suffering from a relapse of drug addiction that was causing disruption in the company's operations. The company's disarray worsened further following Mr. Wilhoit's death in May of 2023. As a result, Mr. Zeffiro began having difficulty getting the company to timely pay Miracle's assessments to the PUC starting in 2022. The company's payroll (managed by headquarters in North Carolina) became unreliable. Mr. Zeffiro personally covered payroll at the Pittsburgh branch on multiple occasions and was reimbursed by the company approximately \$12,000 for doing so. The company rotated through multiple acting CEOs from 2022 to present.

7. Miracle placed Mr. Zeffiro on unpaid "hiatus" from November 22, 2004 to February 1, 2025, during which time he was not authorized to do any work for the company or otherwise represent the company. He was then terminated by the company on April 21, 2025

only to be reinstated on June 2, 2025. On August 8, 2025, Miracle closed its Pittsburgh branch and again terminated Mr. Zeffiro.

8. In or about July of 2024, Miracle directed Mr. Zeffiro not to pay any claims for customer property damage, resulting in the PUC customer complaints referenced in the denial letter. Mr. Zeffiro was also on unpaid “hiatus” or terminated during a large part of the time period critical to these complaints.³ Moreover, these complaints represent fairly routine disputes over property damage claims and do not impugn the ability of Mr. Zeffiro to operate safely and legally.

9. The denial letter further criticizes Mr. Zeffiro because Miracle has not filed an application for abandonment with the Commission. Mr. Zeffiro is not employed by Miracle and is not authorized to file an application for abandonment on their behalf. We have offered to assist them with such an application if authorized, but to date we have received no response. (**Exhibit D**).

10. Mr. Zeffiro founded Drew Moves in the wake of the closure of Miracle’s Pittsburgh branch.⁴ It is currently operating as a “labor only” company and is also in the final stages of securing interstate operating authority from the FMCSA. Mr. Zeffiro hopes to use Drew Moves to leverage his experience and to operate ethically and successfully, without the dysfunction that doomed Miracle.⁵ For the reasons explained above, this was outside of his

³ One of these Complainants, Daniel Hooven, has filed a protest of petitioner’s application. While this protest was filed after the Commission issued its denial, the proper process to adjudicate this is before the Administrative Law Judge, rather than a pre-emptive denial by the Commission.

⁴ Previously, the entity existed as “Drew’s Moving Consultants.” Mr. Zeffiro used the entity to receive payments from Miracle for his work there.

⁵ For a period of time, the Google listing for Miracle Movers Pittsburgh was changed to Drew Moves. This was done accidentally by Mr. Zeffiro in the process of attempting to create a new

control. He is an experienced mover who understands and intends to comply with the obligations of a licensed household goods carrier. He should not be penalized due to the unfortunate conduct of his former employer.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner Drew Moves, LLC respectfully request that the Commission reconsider its prior denial of his application for authority to operate as a motor common carrier of household goods in-use and process said authority.

To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your Application, Docket No. A-2025-3058207 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience **WILL NOT BE GRANTED** for the following reason(s):

On October 21, 2025, applicant submitted an application for additional operating rights. A full review of the application and the applicant's sole member's history with the Commission raises fitness concerns.

Previously, the applicant's sole member, Andrew Zeffiro was employed as the Managing Partner of Miracle Movers of Pittsburgh, LLC (hereinafter "Miracle Movers"), at Docket A-8922412. Of concern to the Commission is Mr. Zeffiro's management of Miracle Movers and his handling of the carrier's fiscal reporting and assessment compliance. In the fiscal years 2021, 2022, and 2024, while under the managerial responsibility of Mr. Zeffiro, the applicant was repeatedly issued assessment warnings and delinquency notifications by the Commission in attempts to collect unreported or unpaid assessments. Although the assessments appear to have been paid, excepting for an outstanding balance for 2024, it was not done without Commission intervention. On March 4, 2024, that the Commission was notified that Mr. Zeffiro would be no-longer serving in the role of Assessment contact for Miracle Movers.

During Mr. Zeffiro's tenure with Miracle Movers the carrier received complaints at Docket C-2020-3022120, which was resolved in the complainant's favor, and at Dockets C-2024-3051987 and C-2025-3056319, which remain open with the Commission and are awaiting final adjudication. Additionally, on September 8, 2025, Enforcement Officer Zalar reported that Mr. Zeffiro provided information to him that Miracle Movers had permanently ceased operations. This admission by Mr. Zeffiro was made during an investigation into 66 Pa.C.S. § 1303 violations, at BP83051728, which were administratively dismissed due to the carrier's closure.

Despite Miracle Mover's obligation to do so, neither it nor its management has yet filed an application for abandonment with the Commission. The failure to do so represents a violation of 66

Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(2), which addresses the abandonment or discontinuance of service, and 52 Pa. Code § 3.381(a)(1)(v). These statutes require a carrier to obtain approval from the Commission prior to ceasing operations.

In the present application, Mr. Zeffiro has presented his experience as the Operations Manager/Managing Partner of Miracle Movers from 2018-2025 to establish his fitness to operate and to demonstrate his experience and knowledge in the Household Goods industry. Unfortunately, a full review of Mr. Zeffiro's history while managing said carrier illustrates a lack of compliance and a history of complaints which represents a disregard for the Commission's regulations and of his responsibilities as a manager/service provider.

For these reasons the application is DISMISSED and DENIED

APPEAL RIGHTS

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§-1.31 and 5.44.



This firm represents Andrew Zeffiro. I am writing because it has come to our attention that persons representing Miracle Movers have directed creditors of Miracle Movers to discuss their accounts with Mr. Zeffiro despite his not being employed by Miracle Movers since August 8, 2025. As recently as last week, he received an inquiry from a towing company stating that Miracle Movers had instructed them to contact him regarding an unpaid bill.

In addition to creating undue stress for Mr. Zeffiro, this is creating confusion that is complicating Mr. Zeffiro's efforts to obtain operating authority from the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission. We therefore ask that you cease and desist from representing to any party that Mr. Zeffiro works for Miracle Movers or is otherwise the correct point of contact for any debt that might be owed by the company. We reserve the right to take legal action against Miracle Movers if this conduct does not immediately stop. Please respond to me via email confirming that you intend to comply.

Finally, Miracle Movers is no longer operating in Pennsylvania and is therefore required to file an Application for Abandonment of Service with the PUC. Your failure to file this form is also complicating Mr. Zeffiro's efforts to secure his own operating authority.
