
On November 21, 2025, the Commission issued its Initial Decision in the above-referenced matter. At that time the Commission served the parties with the Initial Decision and a Secretarial Letter explaining the exceptions and reply exceptions process and deadlines. The parties had until December 11, 2025, to file exceptions to the Initial Decision.

On December 9, 2025, the Complainant Karen Traux, eFiled three documents and identified those documents as, "Answer to Formal Complaint," "Exhibit," and "Motion." After review of Complainant's eFiled documents, it appears that *pro se* Complainant intended her eFilings to be exceptions to the November 21, 2025 Initial Decision.

Additionally, it also appears from the face of the documents eFiled that these documents were not served on the Respondent PPL and did not include a Certificate of Service in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.54.

Therefore, to ensure due process and correct the failure of the Complainant to serve the Respondent, we are placing this Secretarial Letter on the record of the docket and serving it electronically upon the Respondent with a copy of the Complainant's filing.
