Application of the Gettysburg & Northern Railroad for crossing (DOT 593 389 G) alterations where Gardners Station Road (T 397) crosses, at grade, the tracks of Gettysburg & Northern Railroad, located in Tyrone Township, Adams County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated October 31, 2023, we directed the alteration of the public crossing (DOT 593 389 G) where Gardners Station Road (T 397) crosses, at grade, the tracks of Gettysburg & Northern Railroad, located in Tyrone Township, Adams County. All work at the subject crossing was to be completed on or before December 31, 2024.

In a previous letter-petition filed with the Commission on December 6, 2024, Gettysburg & Northern Railroad requested the Commission grant an extension of time in which to complete the project. By Secretarial Letter dated December 17, 2024, the Commission granted an extension of time that established a revised completion date of December 31, 2025.

By letter-petition filed on December 8, 2025, Gettysburg & Northern Railroad requests the Commission grant an additional extension of time in which to complete the work due to funding delays. The project includes federal, state and private funding.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant Gettysburg & Northern Railroad an extension of time to May 31, 2026.

This Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code.

THEREFORE:

The letter-petition received by the Commission on December 8, 2025, from Gettysburg & Northern Railroad be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 9 of our Secretarial Letter dated October 31, 2023, last modified on December 17, 2024, which reads as follows, to wit:

“9. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before December 31, 2025, and that on or before said date Gettysburg & Northern Railroad, report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with this Secretarial Letter.”

be and is hereby modified to read:

9. The alteration of the crossing be completed on or before May 31, 2026, and that on or before said Gettysburg & Northern Railroad, report in writing the date of actual completion of the work to this Commission and certify to the parties of record and this Commission that the work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with this Secretarial Letter.

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated October 31, 2023, remain in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.

All formal documents must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. Documents must be eFiled, mailed or hand delivered. All filings should be addressed to the Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. The Commission will not accept documents delivered by fax or by e-mail. Parties are encouraged to file formal documents by eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission’s website (the account is free of charge) and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
