**Re: Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. Energy Efficiency (“Rider EE”) Rate Filing  
Effective January 1, 2026**

Dear Mr. Homsher:

Enclosed for filing on behalf of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Columbia” or the “Company”) is Tariff Supplement No. 405 to Tariff Gas Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 (“Supplement No. 405”). Supplement No. 405, issued December 17, 2025, to become effective January 1, 2026, establishes a revised rate of \$0.00762 per therm for eligible residential customers for the first year of the Company’s Rider EE Phase II Plan. Also to become effective January 1, 2026, is a rate of \$0.00343 per therm for eligible commercial customers, which was filed as part of the Company’s Tariff Compliance filing in Tariff Supplement No. 404, also filed on December 17, 2025, for the first year of the Company’s Rider EE Phase II Plan. There are no rate changes to the commercial rate from what was filed in the Tariff Compliance filing; therefore, Tariff Page No. 17 is not included in this filing. This information is provided in compliance with the Order of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission entered on December 9, 2025 at Docket No. R-2025-3053499.

Also attached within the filing are the supporting calculations for the Rider EE rate effective January 1, 2026.
