

Efficiency and Conservation Plan :**

PETITION TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES, the Commission on Economic Opportunity (CEO), by and through counsel, Joseph L. Vullo, Esquire, and petitions to intervene in the above-captioned matter averring as follows:

1. The Petitioner, Commission on Economic Opportunity, is a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with its principal office located at 165 Amber Lane, P.O. Box 1127, Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, 18703-1127. CEO's telephone number is (570) 826-0510.

2. CEO is an advocate for its clients - the low-income population of Luzerne County - and has been directly involved in assuring that low-income persons' utility costs are contained through counseling, advice, payment assistance and energy conservation measures.

3. CEO is a community based conservation service provider and a contractor for a number of PPL Electric's universal service program in Northeastern Pennsylvania.

4. CEO seeks permission to intervene in the Petition of PPL Electric for Approval of its Act 129 Phase V Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan.

5. PPL Electric serves customers in numerous counties including Luzerne County and CEO is a customer of PPL Electric.

6. CEO's participation as an active party in this proceeding is required to protect its substantial interests and the substantial interests of the low-income citizens it represents in ensuring

that the low-income individuals have access to EE&C program services. Accordingly, CEO's participation in this proceeding will serve the public interest.

7. CEO preliminarily intends to address the following issues:
 - A. Whether the EE&C Plan meets the requirements of Act 129 and relevant Commission Orders, particularly at they relate to low-income ratepayers.
 - B. Whether the proposed Plan provides for comprehensive and direct install measures.
 - C. Whether the Plan provides for coordination in delivery with Conservation Service Providers and community-based organizations that serve low-income customers.

CEO reserves the right to address other issues.

8. Because CEO represents low-income citizens in Luzerne County, the interests of its clients are not being protected by any other party to this action.

9. CEO has intervened and been granted active party status in prior PUC proceedings involving this company, including prior rate cases and Act 129 proceedings.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the Commission on Economic Opportunity respectfully requests that the Commission:

1. Receive for filing and docket this Petition to Intervene in order that CEO be a party to such proceedings and be placed on all service lists.
2. Grant to CEO active party status with the right to participate in all proceedings relative to this matter.




