Dear Secretary Homsher:

This letter is submitted on behalf of Pike County Light & Power Company (“PCL&P”) in response to the Secretarial Letter issued on December 15, 2025 in this proceeding. The Secretarial Letter seeks information regarding electric distribution company load forecasts submitted to PJM Interconnection, LLC (“PJM”) as authorized by Act 45 of 2025.

Act 45 of 2025 is specific to PJM and authorizes the Commission “investigate the methodologies, data and assumptions used by utilities when developing load forecast **submitted to PJM.**” Section 1804-B (A).

Pike does not obtain electricity supply from PJM nor does Pike submit load forecasts to PJM. Pike obtains its electricity supply through the New York Independent System Operator (“NYISO”).

Accordingly, as Act 45 of 2025 does not pertain to load forecasts submitted to the NYISO and the December 15, 2025 Secretarial Letter only seeks information regarding PJM load forecasts, PCL&P does not have data to provide responsive to Act 45 of 2025 or the December 15, 2025 Secretarial Letter.
