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

**PETITION TO INTERVENE
OF VICTORY BREWING COMPANY**

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.71–5.75, Victory Brewing Company (“Victory Brewing”) petitions to intervene in the above-captioned base rate proceedings filed by Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“PAWC” or “Company”) at the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”). In support of its Petition to Intervene, Victory Brewing states as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. Victory Brewing is an industrial customer that receives water and wastewater services from PAWC in Rate Zone 1. Victory Brewing is also subject to payment of Pollutant Removal Costs under Section U of PAWC’s wastewater tariff.

2. Victory Brewing’s attorneys in this matter are:

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3. On November 14, 2025, PAWC filed Supplement No. 58 to Tariff Water-PA P.U.C. No. 5 (“Supplement No. 58”) with the Commission to become effective January 13, 2026.

Supplement No. 58 proposes to increase PAWC’s total annual operating revenues for water service by approximately \$152.4 million, or 16.1%.

4. Also on November 14, 2025, PAWC’s Wastewater Division filed Supplement No. 61 to Tariff Wastewater PA P.U.C. No. 16 (“Supplement No. 61”) with the Commission to become effective January 13, 2026. Supplement No. 61 proposes to increase PAWC’s total operating revenues for wastewater service by approximately \$16.3 million, or 7.8%.

5. By Orders entered on December 4, 2025, the Commission suspended the rate increases proposed by Supplement No. 58 and Supplement No. 61 for further investigation until August 13, 2026, unless permitted by Commission Order to become effective at an earlier date.

6. A telephonic prehearing conference was held on December 12, 2025.

7. On December 17, 2025, Administrative Law Judges Emily I. DeVoe and Jeffrey A. Watson issued a Prehearing Order setting forth the procedural matters addressed during the prehearing conference, including the litigation schedule.

II. PETITION TO INTERVENE

8. The Commission’s regulations allow intervention where a person has an interest in the proceeding which may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by existing parties, and as to which the person may be bound by the action of the Commission in the proceeding. 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a)(2). Intervention is also permitted where participation of the person may be in the public interest. 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a)(3). A “person” includes a corporation. 52 Pa. Code § 1.8.

9. Victory Brewing meets the standards for intervention set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a). Under PAWC’s proposed rate increase, Victory Brewing’s water and wastewater rates

would be significantly increased, thereby affecting its operations. As such, Victory Brewing has interests that will be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

10. Victory Brewing will be bound by the action of the Commission in this proceeding. The Commission's decision on PAWC's proposals will directly affect the water and wastewater rates charged to Victory Brewing.

11. Additionally, as one of PAWC's largest industrial customers, Victory Brewing possesses an interest which is unique from and not adequately represented by existing participants or other parties that may seek to intervene in this proceeding.

12. For all these reasons, Victory Brewing possesses an "interest which may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by existing participants, and as to which the petitioner may be bound by the action of the Commission in the proceeding." 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a)(1).

13. The scope of issues that Victory Brewing intends to examine and potentially address in this proceeding include the amount of PAWC's proposed increases, as well as the method by which any increases would be allocated to customer classes and within customer classes through PAWC's proposed rate structure, including rate design. In addition, Victory Brewing plans to review issues raised by other parties during the proceeding and consider the impact of any alternative proposals on Victory Brewing's existing and future rates.

14. Victory Brewing accepts the procedural schedule and other procedural matters that were addressed at the prehearing conference, as reflected in the Prehearing Order. At this time, Victory Brewing has not identified a witness for this proceeding but will advise the Administrative Law Judges and parties upon the identification of any witness.

III. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Victory Brewing Company respectfully requests that this Petition to Intervene be granted and that Victory Brewing Company be afforded full party status in this proceeding.
