Re: Application of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company for Approval of Certificates of Public Convenience to Acquire Certain Electric Distribution Facilities from Letterkenny Industrial Development Authority and for the Right to Initiate and Provide Electric Distribution Service in portions of Letterkenny, Greene, and Hamilton Townships, Franklin County, Pennsylvania; Docket Nos. A-2023-3043428

Dear Secretary Homsher:

On December 15, 2025, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA”) completed the purchase of certain electric distribution facilities from Letterkenny Industrial Development Authority (“LIDA”). In accordance with Ordering Paragraph 4 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) Order entered June 13, 2024 in the above-captioned matter, FE PA was permitted to file a supplemental tariff to the Commission applying the terms and conditions of service and rates set forth in its existing Tariff Electric – PA.P.U.C No. 1.

Since FE PA’s existing tariff already includes service for Greene, Hamilton and Letterkenny Townships, FE PA will not be filing a supplemental tariff with respect to the purchase of certain electric distribution facilities from LIDA.

Further, FE PA explained in Paragraph 27 of its Application for Certificate of Public Convenience in the above-captioned matter that the LIDA customers would be served under FE PA’s existing rate schedules, stating in pertinent part:

West Penn is proposing to integrate LIDA’s customers into three existing West Penn rate schedules: Schedule 20 – General Service; Schedule 30 – General Power Service for loads up to 400 kilowatts (“kW”); and Schedule 35 – General Power Service for loads over 400 kW. Schedules 20 and 30 are included in West Penn’s commercial customer class while Schedule 35 is included in West Penn’s industrial customer class.
