REPORT AND ORDER

---

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter being before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission upon application of CLYDE E. YOHEY, trading and doing business as WONDERVIEW SANITARY FACILITIES, received January 23, 1974, for approval of the right to begin to offer, furnish, render, or supply sanitary sewage collection and disposal service to the public in a portion of Main Township and a portion of Catawissa Township, Columbia County, and having been duly presented in accordance with the rules of the Commission, and full investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, the Commission finds and determines that a granting of said application is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience or safety of the public, and that a certificate of public convenience issue evidencing the Commission's approval thereof:

NOW, to wit, March 9, 1976, IT IS ORDERED: That a certificate of public convenience issue evidencing the Commission's approval of the said application, as above determined, as described by courses and distances and shown on a map submitted with the application, subject to the following conditions:

FIRST: That the approval granted by this certificate shall authorize applicant to begin to furnish sewage collection and disposal service to no more than 113 single family residences in his proposed service area.

SECOND: That applicant shall not furnish sewage collection and disposal service to more than the aforesaid 113 single family residences in his proposed service area until applicant obtains approval of the Commission, prior to installation, that applicant's sewage collection and disposal facilities will be of sufficient capacity to furnish adequate service additional dwellings in his proposed service area.

THIRD: That applicant obtain a permit from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources and submit a notarized copy to the Commission before sewage collection and disposal service is offered to the public.

FOURTH: That applicant construct sewage collection and disposal facilities to serve his proposed service area in accordance with his proposals set forth in the application, and the design specifications submitted therewith.

FIFTH: That applicant, by acceptance of the certificate, recognize his obligation to extend service beyond his certificated area as granted by said order, should ultimately the Commission determine, after hearing and with full due process accorded to applicant, that such extension is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public; and should the Commission further determine that such extension, is required, would not represent a taking of applicant's property, but would be reasonably compensatory to him for the investment required.

SIXTH: That applicant comply with the sanitary regulations and requirements of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources in the operation of his sewage collection and disposal facilities.

SEVENTH: That the authorization granted hereby shall not be construed as indicating approval of the rates for service proposed by applicant.
