The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Pittsburgh Water's proposed Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) filing submitted on December 17, 2025 to become effective January 1, 2026. Pittsburgh Water is not proposing to change its currently effective DSIC rate of 5.0%; therefore, no tariff supplement is included with the filing.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed DSIC rate for the three-month period of January 1, 2026 through March 31, 2026 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to remain effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2025-3059335.
