The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Pike County Light & Power Company's proposed Supplement No. 133 to Tariff Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 and the supporting rate computations submitted on December 18, 2025 and revised on December 19, 2025, to become effective on January 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) rate for the three-month period of January 1, 2026 through March 31, 2026 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
