Dear Attorneys Harrold and Bakare:

On October 9, 2025, Pennsylvania-American Water Company – Wastewater Division (PAWC-WD) submitted the above-referenced application (Application) to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) for filing. The Commission subsequently completed a completeness review of the Application using the Application Filing Checklist adopted by the Commission through the Final Supplemental Implementation Order entered July 2, 2024, at Docket No. M-2016-2543193 (July 2024 FSIO).¹ The Commission then conveyed a list of the Application’s deficiencies via email to PAWC-WD on November 12, 2025. On November 25, 2025, PAWC-WD requested an extension of time to respond to the Application deficiencies until December 12, 2025. On December 1, 2025, the Commission granted the requested extension of time via Secretarial Letter. On December 12, 2025, PAWC-WD submitted supplemental information to the Commission, including Application amendments, in response to the application completeness review.

The responses filed by PAWC-WD indicate that the Application will be amended by PAWC-WD “in the near future.” This Secretarial Letter is to inform you that the Application remains incomplete due to the referenced amendments not being included in the submittal. As the Application remains incomplete at this time, PAWC-WD may request a further extension of time to provide a complete Application or may request to withdraw the Application and refile the Application when it is complete. Please be advised that if PAWC-WD does not request an extension of time or does not request to withdraw the Application within ten (10) business days

of the date of this Secretarial Letter, the Application may be rejected pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.38.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition to appeal this staff action with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
