Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc.'s 2024-2028 USECP

RE: Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. 2024-2028 Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan

Overview

On December 9, 2025, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) entered an Order (December 2025 Order) at Docket No. R-2025-3053499, which approved the terms and conditions of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc.'s (Columbia's) 2025 Base Rate Case. The December 2025 Order directed Columbia to, *inter alia*, amend its 2024-2028 Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan (2024 USECP) to reflect that Columbia will conduct a monthly review of all Customer Assistance Plan (CAP) accounts to ensure customers receive the most affordable rate. December 2025 Order at 430, ¶20.

On December 18, 2025, Columbia filed clean and redline versions of a revised page 29 of its 2024 USECP incorporating the CAP account review provision approved through the December 2025 Order.

The Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services (BCS) reviewed Columbia's proposed revision of its 2024 USECP and finds it consistent with the change directed in the December 2025 Order.


Conclusion

Accordingly, BCS finds Columbia's proposed revision to its 2024 USECP to be compliant with the December 2025 Order. Parties have the right to seek reconsideration of this staff action. These staff determinations relative to the review of the amendment to Columbia's 2024 USECP will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission unless reconsideration is sought from

the Commission within 20 days after service of this Secretarial Letter. See 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for appeal from actions of the staff).
