In regards to the above-referenced matters, Powervine and Clearview submit this notice as their intent to assign approximately 2,847 customers from Powervine to Clearview. The date of the proposed assignment is January 1, 2026.

The electric utility service territories involved in this customer assignment are: Duquesne Light, Metropolitan Edison Company, Penelec, West Penn Power, Penn Power, PECO Energy and PPL Electric Utilities. The contract terms and conditions of the assigned contracts will remain unchanged. Enclosed please find a copy of the notification that Powervine and Clearview will send to customers that will be assigned to Clearview.

Both Powervine and Clearview have filed all electric choice reports with the Commission which reflect their most recent gross receipts for the last four quarters. Additionally, all financial collateral in place for both Powervine and Clearview are current with the Commission and all annual electric fees due for both Powervine and Clearview have been paid. Enclosed please find documentation from AEPS showing that Powervine and Clearview are in compliance. Also enclosed and marked confidential are the past 4 quarters (Q4 2024 through Q3 2025) of GRT for the customers being assigned.

Powervine Energy, LLC ("Powervine") greatly appreciates the opportunity to serve as the supplier of electricity for your Utility Account. We are writing to inform you that Powervine will be assigning your electricity supply service to Clearview Energy, LLC ("Clearview"), another electric generation supplier licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PAPUC"), effective on or after January 1, 2026.

Clearview is run by an experienced team of energy experts with decades of retail energy supply and utility experience. The Clearview team's experience in deregulated energy markets enables them to offer fixed and variable prices paired with responsive and customer-friendly support.

No action is required on your part when this transfer occurs. Your contract is assignable in accordance with your terms of service. Clearview will honor your current agreement with Powervine, and there will be no changes to the terms and conditions, except those otherwise allowed by your terms and conditions, through the life of your current contract. This transfer will not cause an interruption of your electricity services and you should continue to pay your utility bill as normal. The same quality of support and service that you are used to with Powervine will continue with Clearview.

If you have a fixed rate plan with Powervine, your service will continue with the same fixed rate until the end of your contract term or upon cancellation of service (termination fees may apply). If you are currently served under a variable rate with Powervine, your service will continue with Clearview's variable electric rate. You may also contact Clearview directly to see what other options are available, including renewal options if your contract expires soon.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will my electricity be cut off?

No, this transfer will not cause an interruption of your electricity services and you should continue to pay your utility bill as normal. Your Utility bill will outline your options for submitting payment. After the transfer is complete, you will begin to see your Clearview listed on your utility bill, which will include both your utility and supplier charges. If you have any unpaid charges, Powervine may bill you directly for any amounts owed prior to the assignment of your contract.

Whom do I call in case of a power outage or emergency?

Your Utility has not changed; you should call your utility for any outage or emergency, just as you do today.

Will my current rate change?

If you have a fixed rate plan with Powervine, your service will continue with the same fixed rate until the end of your contract term or upon cancellation of service (termination fees may apply). If you are currently served under a variable rate with Powervine, your service will continue with Clearview's variable electricity rate. After your service is transferred, you may also contact Clearview directly to see what other options are available.

Will my meter read cycle or utility charges change?

No, you will continue to receive your bill from your utility as you always have. The only change is that Clearview will be listed as the electric generation supplier.

What will happen to my contract/agreement with Powervine?

Clearview will honor your current agreements with Powervine, so except for those allowed in accordance with your terms and conditions, no changes will occur to your terms or conditions until the contract end date. If you are a Powervine customer on a variable rate plan, the variable electricity rate will continue to remain variable. You will also be eligible to renew to a fixed-rate plan.

My contract was about to expire with Powervine, what does this mean for me?

If your contract expires before the effective date of your transfer, your service will continue under the same terms outlined in your renewal notice. If your contract expires after the effective date of your transfer and you have already received a renewal notice from Powervine, your service will also continue under those same renewal terms. Once your account has been transferred, you're welcome to contact Clearview to explore any alternative plans or options that may better fit your needs.

Do I need to do anything to switch to Clearview?

No, you will not need to do anything. We will make this transition as smooth as possible for you. Powervine will assign your electricity supply service to Clearview, another electric generation supplier licensed by the PAPUC.

When can I expect Clearview to become my official supplier?

Powervine will assign your electricity supply service to Clearview, another electric generation supplier licensed by the PAPUC, effective on or after January 1, 2026.

Will I need to sign up with Clearview or go through a credit check?

No, Clearview welcomes you as their customer in a clear and hassle-free way.

How will I know when I have started services with Clearview?

Clearview will appear as your electric generation supplier in the energy supply portion of your utility bill.

Will I be able to opt out of the switch to Clearview?

You can only opt out of the switch to Clearview by requesting to drop to your utility or switch to another electric generation supplier while active with Powervine. Early Termination Fees will apply if applicable.


