
The Commission is reviewing the Petition that you filed on December 5, 2025, on behalf of Finch Wireless.AI Inc (Finch Wireless) wherein Finch Wireless seeks designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the purpose of providing Lifeline service to qualifying customers.

The Commission's regulations require that all petitions must be served on other parties whom petitioner believes will be affected by the petition, as well as with the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and the Office of Small Business Advocate. 52 Pa. Code § 5.41. Further, such service must be evidenced with a certificate of service filed with the petition. *Id.*

The Petition contains no evidence that service was effectuated on the above-mentioned parties. As such, the Commission will refrain from further consideration of the Petition until Finch Wireless files proof of service with the Commission that copies of the Petition have been served on the Pennsylvania Telephone Association, all affected incumbent local exchange companies and all of the statutory parties required under Section 5.41. The parties will thereafter have 20 days to file an answer to the Petition. 52 Pa. Code § 5.61.
