NOTICE OF ABANDONMENT

On August 1, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issued an Order granting an application by Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia") seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience authorizing it to abandon natural gas service to One Active and One Inactive Residential Premises located in Mayport, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania. As of December 29, 2025, the abandonment of these Premises have been completed. - (a) The completion date for the abandonment of gas service to the one active and one inactive residential premises:




