**PREHEARING ORDER FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

AND NOW, this 8th day of January 2026, it is hereby ORDERED:

**1. DATE AND TIME OF HEARING.** An evidentiary hearing will be held in this case on:

**Tuesday, February 3, 2026, beginning at 10:00 AM**

To participate in the hearing, you must dial the toll-free number listed below. You will be prompted to enter a PIN number, which is also listed below. You will be asked to speak your name, press the # key, and then the telephone system will connect you to the hearing. If you have any witnesses you want to have present during the hearing who are participating from a separate phone, you must provide them with the telephone number and PIN Number.

**2. CONTINUANCES.** Continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuance, you must submit a motion at least five (5) days before the hearing.

**3. PRESENTING EXHIBITS.** If you intend to present any documents or exhibits at the hearing, you must email one (1) copy to the Presiding Officers at [sthaas@pa.gov](mailto:sthaas@pa.gov) and [efarren@pa.gov](mailto:efarren@pa.gov) and one (1) copy each must be sent to every other party pursuant to paragraph 4B below. All copies must be received at least five (5) business days before the hearing.

Proposed exhibits shall be properly pre-marked for identification purposes. **Each party shall**

**remit a master list of proposed exhibits, including pre-served testimony, in Word format to the Presiding Officers.**

**4. FILING AND SERVING DOCUMENTS.** When you file a document, you must provide the original to the PUC and serve a copy to the other party or parties. Instructions on how to file with the PUC and serve other parties are provided below.

**A. FILING DOCUMENTS**

**(1) E-FILING.** Parties are encouraged to use e-Filing.

**(2) PAPER FILING.** If you do not have the capability to open and use an e-Filing account, you may file paper documents with the Secretary of the Commission. Filing of paper documents may be hand delivered or sent to:

**(3) CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL.** If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing should be submitted by overnight delivery to ensure arrival. Filings containing confidential or proprietary material may also be submitted through the Commission's Share Point File system. These filings should be followed by a hard copy for the Commission's file. Filers should contact the Secretary's Bureau in advance to set up a Share Point File before submitting the filing.

**B. SERVING DOCUMENTS**

**(1) SERVING OTHER PARTIES.** When you file documents with the PUC, you must also serve a copy on the other party or parties. While you may serve a copy by U.S. First-Class Mail or by hand, eService or email is preferred if the other party has agreed to electronic service. For your convenience, a copy of the PUC's current service list of all parties to this proceeding is enclosed with this Order.

**(2) SERVING THE PRESIDING OFFICERS.** Be sure that you serve the Presiding Officers directly with a copy of any document that you file in this proceeding at the time of its filing. You must email one (1) copy to the Presiding Officers at [sthaas@pa.gov](mailto:sthaas@pa.gov) and [efarren@pa.gov](mailto:efarren@pa.gov). **5. REPRESENTATION.** Partnerships, corporations, limited liability companies, trusts, associations, or governmental agencies or subdivisions, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted *pro hac vice*.<sup>1</sup>

**6. CONTACT INFORMATION.** If your email address or telephone number changes during the course of the proceeding, you must immediately update the Office of Administrative Law Judge by calling 717-787-1399.

**7. ACCOMMODATION.** Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the PUC scheduling office at least five (5) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

If you require an interpreter to participate in the hearing, we will have an interpreter present. Please call the scheduling office at the PUC at least ten (10) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.
