Re: PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's Request for Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Staff Approval of a CSP Contract for EM&V Services, at Docket No. M-2025-3057329

Dear Ms. Rulli:

This letter acknowledges that Commission staff has reviewed the Evaluation Measurement and Verification ("EM&V") Act 129 Conservation Service Provider ("CSP") Contract between PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL") and The Cadmus Group LLC ("Cadmus"), filed with the Commission on December 1, 2025. With this Letter, Commission staff tolls the 45-day deadline to review CSP Contracts.

The *Phase V Implementation Order*,¹ *inter alia*, required all Electric Distribution Companies subject to Act 129 to submit, for Commission review, all proposed contracts with a CSP. (*Phase V Implementation Order*, Section G, pages 227-230). The Commission must review, and may order the modification of, these proposed contracts. 66 Pa. C.S. § 2806.1(a)(8).

PPL is advised that the above-referenced CSP Contract is not approved at this time, for the reasons set forth below. Commission staff tolls the 45-day deadline and requests that PPL remedy the issues listed in Attachment A. Once the issues in Attachment A have been remedied, Commission staff will finalize review of the CSP Contract.

The determinations in this Secretarial Letter have been made by PUC staff under authority delegated by the Commission. Parties have the right to seek reconsideration of

this staff action. Parties may seek reconsideration of these directives by petitioning the Commission within 20 days after service of this Secretarial Letter. See 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for appeal from actions of the staff).

EM&V CSP Contract

1. PPL's EM&V CSP Contract filing is missing the required separate cover sheet. Pursuant to Page 228 of the *Phase V Implementation Order* a utility is required to provide with its CSP Contract submission a separate cover sheet to provide a summary of the following information:
 - Full company name of contractor and CSP registration Docket Number;
 - Brief description of statement of work (SOW);
 - Name of EE&C plan program(s) associated with proposed contract and explanation if SOW addresses the program in its entirety or in part;
 - Estimated total contract cost and statement regarding incentives and rebates, their amount, and explanation if total cost includes incentives and rebates;
 - Estimated targeted energy savings and peak demand reduction associated with contract;
 - Timeframe and duration of contract from start date to completion; and
 - Statement relating to the number of bids that were received, justification for selection of CSP contractor/subcontractor if based on receipt of less than three bids for any particular program, and identification and explanation for non-selection of low-bid CSP, if applicable.

2. The CSP Registration of Cadmus expired on July 14, 2025. As of January 8, 2026, Cadmus is still not a registered CSP with the Commission. Since its registration has expired, Cadmus will need to file a new CSP registration with the Commission.
