

- 2.) In your answer to #3 of the verified statements you mention contracts with Access2Care.
 - a. Are you currently contracting with Access2Care?
 - b. Why was no PUC permit requested for this contract?
- 3.) In answer #3 of the verified statements you also mention a partnership with Uber.
 - a) Please describe the on-demand service you provided for Uber.
 - b) Did you log onto the Uber App each time a vehicle was dispatched?
 - c) Please submit the contract between Uber and Green Car Care Inc for these services.
- 4.) Which under-resourced communities do you refer to in your application?
- 5.) Regarding your drivers: The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa.
