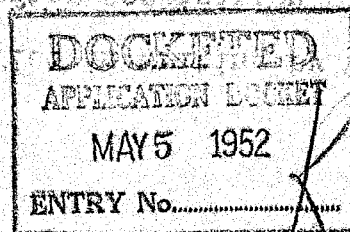
O R D E R

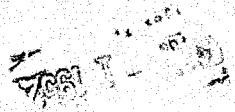
BY THE COMMISSION, APRIL 28, 1952:

The matters and things involved in this application having been duly submitted and heard, and full consideration having been given thereto, we find and determine that it is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public that The Scranton Electric Company acquire all the property and rights of Abington Electric Company; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the acquisition by The Scranton Electric Company and the transfer by Abington Electric Company of all the property and rights of Abington Electric Company be and are hereby approved, and that a certificate of public convenience evidencing approval issue at A. 78384, subject to the condition that the approval hereby given is not to be understood as requiring the Commission, in any proceedings brought before it for any purpose, to place a value on said property and rights equal to the cost of constructing and acquiring them, or equal to the consideration to be paid for them by The Scranton Electric Company, or as requiring the Commission to approve or prescribe rates which will yield a return on said cost of construction and acquisition or on said consideration.





2. That the Commission be notified in writing by The Scranton Electric Company within 30 days after acquisition of the property and rights of Abington Electric Company of the date of such acquisition.
