
On December 24, 2025, you attempted to file a “Petition for Reconsideration / Appeal of Denial” of the Commission’s December 3, 2025, denial of your Application for Transportation Network Service License at Docket Number A-2025-3058716. In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.4, 1.32, 5.41, and 5.44, Petitions for Reconsideration to Staff Action must be properly filed with the Commission (52 Pa. Code §§ 1.4, 1.32) and must also be filed within 20 days of the service date of the Secretarial Letter Denying the Application (52 Pa. Code §§ 5.41, 5.44).

In the above captioned case, a Petition for Reconsideration was due to be filed by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on Tuesday, December 23, 2025. You submitted your Petition for Reconsideration on December 24, 2025. Therefore, your Petition for Reconsideration is untimely. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.41, 5.44.

Additionally, all filings with the Commission shall be made by (1) First-Class Mail, or (2) hand delivered, or (3) through the Commission’s electronic filing system (eFiled). You submitted your Petition for Reconsideration via email to an email account not associated with the filings of Petitions for Reconsideration. Therefore, you failed to properly file your Petition for Reconsideration with the Commission. 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.4, 1.32.

Consequently, your filing is rejected for failure to comply with 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.4, 1.32, 5.41, and 5.44 and is being returned to you under cover of this letter.
