Please explain your hiring standards for drivers; **(Title 52 Pa Code §29.503 – Age Restrictions)** Are there any age restrictions?

Per Title 52 Pa Code §29.503 drivers are required to be 21 years of age.

Your system for conducting criminal background checks; **(Title 52 Pa Code §29.505 – Criminal History)**

How often will you conduct criminal background checks?

Per Title 52 Pa Code §29.505 RHS will conduct background checks prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter.

What type of things in their criminal background check would disqualify them from employment?

Felonies, theft, drug trafficking, terrorism, sexual assault and significant driving infractions would disqualify potential drivers.

How will you maintain records (record retention) of the criminal background checks performed?

Records will be maintained at place of business, secured with lock and key.

Please further clarify your driver training program. Will there be any hands-on driver training, or defensive driving courses?

Hands-on driver training will be scheduled with an RHS supervisor at the location of the detail.

Your system for conducting driver license/history checks; **(Title 52 Pa Code §29.504 – Driver History)**

How often will you conduct driver license/history checks?

Per Title 52 Pa Code §29.504 driver license/history checks will be conducted prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter.


How will you maintain records (record retention) of such checks?
