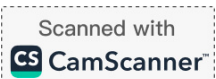



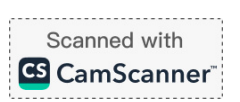

7 VEHICLE SAFETY PROGRAM

Light CARE TRANSPORTATION INC, HAS ESTABLISHED A COMPREHENSIVE VEHICLE SAFETY PROGRAM; ALL VEHICLES OPERATED BY COMPANY ARE MAINTAINED IN A SAFE AND ROADWORTHY CONDITION AT ALL TIMES & CONTINUOUSLY COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND INSPECTION STANDARDS UNDER 67 PA CODE, CHAPTER 175.

- PERIODIC VEHICLE MAINTENANCE PLAN

1. DAILY PRE-TRIP & POST-TRIP VISUAL INSPECTIONS BY DRIVERS.
2. ROUTINE PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE BASED ON MANUFACTURED RECOMMENDATIONS.
3. PENNSYLVANIA STATE SAFETY INSPECTION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
4. CORRECTS REPAIRS WHEN DEFECTS OR SAFETY CONCERNS ARE IDENTIFIED.

b. COMPLIANCE WITH PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE EQUIPMENT STANDARDS

LIGHT. CARE TRANSPORTATION INC, MAINTAINS CONTINUOUS COMPLIANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE EQUIPMENT STANDARDS AS SET FORTH IN 67 PA CODE CHAPTER 175.

COMPLIANCE IS ENSURED THROUGH

- VERIFICATION THAT ALL VEHICLES MEET PENNSYLVANIA INSPECTION & EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENT.
- MAINTAIN VALID INSPECTION STICKERS
- DRIVER TRAINING TO IDENTIFY & REPORT MECHANICAL OR SAFETY ISSUES PROMPTLY
- MAINTAIN RECORDS DOCUMENTING INSPECTIONS REPAIRS & SERVICING.

Vehicle Safety Program Plan

1. Routine Vehicle Inspections

All vehicles will undergo regular safety inspections to ensure they remain in proper operating condition.

- Each vehicle will receive a comprehensive safety inspection at least once every 12 months by a certified Pennsylvania inspection station.
- Vehicles will display a valid PA inspection sticker at all times.
- Internal inspections will be conducted monthly by the operator or designated staff to check critical systems, including:
 - Brakes and tires
 - Steering and suspension
 - Lights and signals
 - Windshield, mirrors, and wipers
 - Horn, seat belts, and safety equipment
- Inspection results will be documented and retained for a minimum of two years.

Any vehicle found to be unsafe will be removed from service immediately until repairs are completed.

2. Preventative Maintenance Program

A preventative maintenance schedule will be followed to reduce breakdowns and ensure vehicle safety.

- Maintenance will be performed according to manufacturer recommendations and industry standards.
- Services will include, but are not limited to:
 - Oil and filter changes
 - Brake inspections and servicing
 - Tire rotation and replacement
 - Fluid checks and replacements
 - Battery and electrical system checks
 - Engine and transmission servicing
- Maintenance records will be kept for each vehicle, including dates, services

performed, and repair invoices.

- All repairs will be completed by qualified technicians or licensed repair facilities.

3. Driver Pre-Trip and Post-Trip Inspections

Drivers are responsible for inspecting their assigned vehicle before and after each shift.

Pre-Trip Inspection

Before operating a vehicle, the driver will inspect:

- Tires and wheels
- Brakes and steering
- Headlights, brake lights, turn signals, and hazard lights
- Windshield, mirrors, and wipers
- Horn and seat belts
- Fuel level and fluid leaks
- Cleanliness and safety of passenger areas

Any defect affecting safety will be reported immediately, and the vehicle will not be operated until corrected.

Post-Trip Inspection

After each shift, the driver will:

- Check for new damage or mechanical issues
- Remove debris and ensure the vehicle is clean
- Report any problems encountered during operation
- Complete and submit an inspection log

All inspection forms will be retained as part of the vehicle's safety records.

4. Compliance with PA Vehicle Equipment Standards

All vehicles will meet or exceed Pennsylvania vehicle equipment requirements and inspection standards, including those outlined in *67 Pa. Code, Chapter 175*.

- Vehicles will be equipped with all required safety equipment, including:
 - Proper lighting systems
 - Functional brakes and steering
 - Mirrors, windshield, and wipers in good condition

- Working seat belts for all seating positions
- Tires meeting tread depth and condition standards
- Vehicles will not be modified in any way that violates PA regulations.
- Any equipment found to be non-compliant will be repaired immediately.

5. Documentation and Oversight

- All inspection, maintenance, and repair records will be maintained in a vehicle file.
- Records will be available for review by regulatory agencies upon request.
- The operator will conduct periodic audits to ensure compliance with this program and state regulations.

8. (X) Light Care Transportation INC. has contacted License Commercial Insurance Providers to Obtain coverage meeting PA Public utility Commission requirements for non-Emergency Medical Transportation services.
