\$82.50	MINIMUM CHARGE PER QUARTER

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PITTSBURGH CITY COUNCIL, COUNTY OF LUZERNE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, RE-ENACTING THE CITY SEWER MAINTENANCE FEE UNCHANGED FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 RATES IN ALIGNMENT WITH THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of The City of Pittsburgh, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Pittsburgh City Code §386-17 the City of Pittsburgh is authorized to charge an annual Sewer Maintenance Fee and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Pittsburgh City Code §386-18(A) the said Sewer Maintenance Fee is set by Resolution of the Pittsburgh City Council and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pittsburgh that the following Pittsburgh City Sewer Maintenance Fee rates, unchanged from 2025, and based on customer water meter readings provided by the Pennsylvania American Water Company, are re-enacted and continued effective January 1, 2026 in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2026 approved city budget and remain in full force and effect until modified by a Resolution of the City Council:

\$82.50	0 TO 15,000 GALLONS PER CALENDAR YEAR QUARTER
\$4.25	FOR EACH ADDITIONAL ONE THOUSAND (1,000) GALLONS PER QUARTER OR FRACTION THEREOF PER QUARTER OVER FIFTEEN THOUSAND (15,000) GALLONS
\$82.50	MINIMUM CHARGE PER QUARTER

AND FURTHERMORE, in accordance with Pittsburgh City Code §386-20(C), these charges will continue to be billed to all properties within the City of Pittsburgh and all existing external connections in accordance with Pittsburgh City Code §386-17(B), by Berkheimer Associates, under existing contract with the City of Pittsburgh, and delinquent accounts shall be billed and collected in accordance with existing city policies and procedures;

AND FURTHERMORE BE IT RESOLVED that Pittsburgh City Code Section §386-20(G) is revised to read as follows:

Operational procedures and policies for collection.

(1) The owner of the each EDU will be billed by the collection agent for the year (§ **386-20A**) on a quarterly basis, at the rate set forth by resolution of the City Council in accordance with § **386-18A** with the option to remit the full annual payment, with no discount, with the first yearly billing. Any past due amount on the account shall be added to the amount billed.

(2) The basis of the billing owner will be the report provided on the gallons of water utilized for the previous quarter, from billing information obtained from the PA American Water Company,

at the rate set forth by resolution of the City Council in accordance with § 386-18A. Any past due amount on the account shall be added to the amount billed.

(All other existing provisions of this section remain unchanged.)
