22. Other requirements. Demonstrate compliance with the following:
- a. For **wastewater** system acquisitions, demonstrate compliance with the DEP-approved Act 537 Official Sewage Facilities Plans for the affected municipalities (including the extent of the requested service territory).

RESPONSE:

- a. PAWC’s proposed acquisition of the City of Pittston’s wastewater collection system aligns with the DEP-approved Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority (WVSA) Act 537 Plans. WVSA’s Act 537 Plan documents can be found in their website at <https://www.wvsa-pa.gov/advanced-search?keywords=Act+537>. The requested service territory remains unchanged from the area currently served by the City of Pittston, and PAWC will continue to operate the system as outlined in the plan. A DEP file review for the City of Pittston was conducted in the fall of 2025 and yielded several legacy documents; however, no Act 537 Official Sewage Facilities document was found. A 1973 Sewerage Planning Greater Pittston Community Area document was located and is included in **Appendix A-22-b**. PAWC, in coordination with the City of Pittston, will prepare and secure DEP approval of an Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update prior to transactional close.
