RE: Corner Water Supply & Service Corporation's Petition for Waiver of the Lead Service Line Replacement Program Requirements. P-2025-3053395

Dear Attorney Cummings:

On February 13, 2025, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.43, (relating to petitions for issuance, amendment, repeal or waiver of Commission regulations), Corner Water Supply & Service Corporation (Corner Water) filed a Petition for a Waiver of 52 Pa. Code § 65.54.(a) (relating to petitioning the Commission for a LSLR program) and all associated requirements concerning a Lead Service Line Replacement (LSLR) program at Docket No. P-2025-3053395 (LSLR Program Waiver Petition).

In the intervening period, on September 2, 2025, the Commission approved the previously filed Joint Application of Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC) and Corner Water to approve the transfer, by sale, of all assets, property, and rights of Corner Water to PAWC.<sup>1</sup> On November 20, 2025, PAWC filed a notice of closing of the transaction with Corner Water at Docket No. A-2025-3052745 that indicated the sale of Corner Water assets to PAWC was completed on November 20, 2025.

On January 8, 2026, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.82, (relating to withdrawal or termination) Corner Water filed a petition for leave to withdraw (Withdrawal Petition) Corner Water's LSLR Program Waiver Petition. Corner Water averred that it is in the public interest to grant its Withdrawal Petition because customers formerly served by Corner Water are now served by PAWC, and PAWC has pending before the Commission a Petition for Approval of PAWC's LSLR Program at Docket No. P-2024-3050263. Corner Water also provided a certificate of service that evidenced that all parties of record for Corner Water's LSLR Program Waiver Petition were served with a copy of Corner Water's Withdrawal Petition.

In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §1.82(a), if no party has objected to Corner Water's Withdrawal Petition within 10 days of service, the Corner Water matter may be stricken by the Commission. To date, the Commission has not received any objections. Therefore, effective

<sup>1</sup> See *Joint Application of Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC) and Corner Water Supply and Service Corporation under 66 Pa.C.S. § 1102(a), for approval: (1) the transfer, by sale, of all assets, property, and rights of Corner Water owned and used in connection with its water system to PAWC, (2) the right of PAWC to begin to offer, render, furnish and supply water service to the public in portions of Elk and Paint Townships, Clarion County, Pennsylvania, currently served by Corner Water, and (3) the abandonment of Corner Water of water service to the public.* Docket Nos. A-2025-3052745 and A-2025-3052747 (Order entered September 2, 2025).

January 20, 2026, Corner Water's Withdrawal Petition is approved, Corner Water's LSLR Program Waiver Petition at Docket No. P-2025-3053395 is hereby withdrawn as moot, and the Commission's proceedings at Docket No. P-2025-3053395 will now be marked closed.
