**INTERIM ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S
MOTION TO CONVERT HEARING
FROM IN-PERSON TO TELEPHONIC**

On November 6, 2025, the Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement (I&E) filed a Formal Complaint against Eddystone Borough (Eddystone, Respondent, or the Borough) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). In the Complaint, I&E alleged that the Borough violated the Pennsylvania One Call Law in connection with a 2-inch gas service line operated by PECO Energy Company – Gas in the vicinity of 1248 E. 12th Street, Eddystone Borough, Delaware County, Pennsylvania.

On November 26, 2025, the Borough filed its Answer to the Complaint. In the Answer, the Borough denied that it violated the Pennsylvania One Call Law.

By Initial In-Person Hearing Notice dated December 4, 2025, an Initial In-Person Hearing was scheduled to be held in Philadelphia on Wednesday, January 28, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.

On December 30, 2025, Grant Rosul, Esquire, Prosecutor for I&E, filed a Motion to Change Hearing Type to Telephonic. In support of the request, Mr. Rosul indicated: that I&E intends to call Sara Locke, Supervisor of the Damage Prevention Section of I&E as a witness; that Supervisor Locke is located in Harrisburg; that Mr. Rosul is also located in Harrisburg; and that holding the January 28, 2026, hearing in-person in Philadelphia would require at least two hours for travel to Philadelphia on the day before the hearing, and a full day to conduct the

hearing and return to Harrisburg. Mr. Rosul averred that holding the hearing telephonically would require no more than one to two hours of Commission staff time and no travel expenses. I&E endorsed its Motion with a Notice to Plead. To date, the Respondent has not filed a response to I&E's Motion.

As I&E's request is reasonable and unopposed, it will be granted in the ordering paragraphs below. A Hearing Notice will be issued separately to the parties that will provide the call-in information for the January 28, 2026, hearing.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Motion to Change Hearing Type to Telephonic filed by the Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement in the matter Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement v. Eddystone Borough at Docket No. C-2025-3058375 is granted.
2. That the in-person hearing scheduled to be held in Philadelphia on January 28, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. is converted to a telephonic hearing.
3. That the Office of Administrative Law Judge Scheduling Unit issue a Hearing Notice informing the parties of the call-in information for the January 28, 2026, hearing.
