Transmission Lines; Telephonic Prehearing Conference

A-2025-3059443. PPL Electric Utilities Corporation. Letter of notification of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation filed under 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57, Subchapter G (relating to Commission review of siting and construction of electric transmission lines) for approval to build approximately 1.1 miles of new double-circuit 230 kilovolt (kV) transmission taps (Tap Lines) that are needed to connect the existing Susquehanna-Harwood #1 & #2 230 kV transmission lines to the new Tomhicken 230 kV Switchyard that are respectively located in Luzerne County.

Formal protests and petitions to intervene must be filed in accordance with 52 Pa. Code (relating to public utilities) on or before March 13, 2026. Filings must be made with the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, with a copy served on the applicant.
