120-Day Status Report, Requesting that the Stay Be Extended for Another 120 Days

Dear Secretary Homsher:

In accordance with Paragraph 3 of Stay Order #2 issued on September 22, 2025, Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. ("VWPA") hereby files this 120-day status report to advise the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") on the progress of negotiations to resolve this matter. For the reasons discussed below, VWPA respectfully requests that the stay be extended for another 120 days to allow the parties to negotiate a comprehensive settlement and to file a Settlement Petition and all necessary attachments.

On September 16, 2025, VWPA e-mailed a status report to Administrative Law Judge Coogan (the "ALJ") indicating that VWPA and Wonderview were continuing to negotiate separate agreements for the transfer of the Wonderview Water system, the Wonderview Wastewater system, and certain real property presently owned by Mr. Yohey that is used by Wonderview to provide public utility service. By e-mail of December 5, 2025, VWPA notified the ALJ that VWPA had executed agreements for the purchase of Wonderview Water Company, Inc. and Wonderview Sanitary Facilities, Inc. as well as certain assets owned by Mr. Yohey that those utilities use in the public service.

VWPA's e-mail of December 5, 2025 also requested guidance from the ALJ regarding the procedure going forward. VWPA explained that the original Motion to Stay the Proceeding contemplated that, if VWPA and Wonderview could reach an agreement, they would file applications pursuant to Section 1102, and the existing 529 Investigation would be held in abeyance pending the disposition of those application proceedings and closed after closing of the transactions. In the December 5 e-mail, VWPA noted that, in two recent Section 529 Investigations (the Winola Water Company proceeding at Docket Nos. P-2018-3006216 *et al*, and the Delaware Sewer Company proceeding at Docket No. I-2016-2526085), the Commission approved settlements in which the parties agreed to the transfer of the utilities in the Section 529 proceedings without the need for separate 1102 proceedings. VWPA requested permission to try to reach a settlement with the other parties to the instant proceeding to transfer the Wonderview Water and Wastewater Systems in the existing Section 529 proceeding. By e-mail of December 8, 2025, the ALJ approved VWPA's request.

Since that time, VWPA has been preparing a Settlement Term Sheet with numerous attachments (including maps and/or legal descriptions of the Water Service Territory and the Wastewater Service Territory, *pro forma* tariff supplements for the Water System and the Wastewater System and Plans for Improvements for the Water System and the Wastewater System). This is a substantial undertaking.

VWPA hopes to share the Settlement Term Sheet, together with some or all attachments, with the other parties soon. The other parties will need time to review and digest the numerous documents in order to respond to the Settlement Term Sheet. VWPA is hopeful that a comprehensive settlement can be reached with all the parties, but that will take time.

Considering the amount of work that remains to be completed, VWPA requests that the ALJ extend the stay in this proceeding. Specifically, VWPA requests that the ALJ direct VWPA to:

(a) provide a 60-day status report to the ALJ via e-mail; and

(b) file a status report with the Secretary's Bureau at the end of the 120-day stay period indicating whether the stay should be extended and, if so, for how long or, in the alternative, advising the ALJ that the Section 529 Investigation should proceed.

VWPA has discussed this request for an extension of the stay with counsel for the other active parties to this proceeding (*i.e.*, Wonderview, the Office of Small Business Advocate, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Department of Environmental Protection and Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc.). VWPA is authorized to report that none of these parties object to the request to extend the stay.
