

Dear Secretary Homsher:

Please be advised that I am general counsel to Newtown Artesian Water Company, Inc. (“NAWC”), in the above-referenced matter. By electronic filing, I am submitting NAWC’s quarterly Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) update effective February 1, 2026. This filing does not include a tariff supplement that would adjust the DSIC surcharge rate. NAWC’s DSIC rate will remain at 0%.

NAWC is permitted to collect the DSIC surcharge in accordance with, *inter alia*, the Commission’s decision dated February 20, 2025 (“Order”) approving NAWC’s base rate case filed at Docket No. R-2024-3050208 (“Rate Case”). The Order permits NAWC to collect DSIC when the original investment (i.e., total depreciable plant) portion of its net plant in service calculation exceeds \$56,297,809.86. This figure is NAWC’s anticipated total depreciable plant in service by March 31, 2026, which is the end of the Full Projected Future Test Year reported in the Rate Case.
