## **Scope of Operating Authority**

A-00107294, Folder 2 Am-C

To Transport, as a common carrier, persons, in Paratransit service, between points in the County of Bucks and from points in said county, to points in the counties of Northampton, Lehigh, Montgomery and Philadelphia, and vice versa;

Subject to the following condition:

- 1) That any service provided under the authority granted herein shall be provided in vehicles having a seating capacity of Twenty-eight (28) passengers or less, excluding the driver.
- 2) That no right, power of privilege is granted to originate service from points in the county of Montgomery.

## RULES AND REGULATION

- 1) Advance reservations must be made not later than the previous calendar day.
- 2) Mileage will be determined by the Official Transportation Map of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3) In instances where the carrier is requested to wait for a passenger or passengers when it is not feasible to dispatch a different vehicle for pick-up of those passengers, an additional charge of \$6.00 will be imposed.
- 4) Carrier will upon request of passenger(S) allow an escort at no charge upon presentation of a physician's certificate that escort service is required.
- 5) Senior Citizens:  
The rates for senior citizens, having proper identification, will be 15% of the shared ride rate rounded upward to the nearest nickel, provided that the carrier is under contract with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation under the provision of Section 704 of Act 36 of 1991 (the Lottery Fund Preservation Act).
- 6) Contract Service:  
Contract service provided will be for a term of not less than 30 days for prequalified persons under a federal, state county or municipal governmental agency contract. Rates for the services will be specified in the respective contracts. Copies of which, including any amendments thereto, are to be filed with the Commission as executed to become effective on one day's notice.
