Re: Affiliated Service Agreement between Duquesne Light Company and Its Affiliate Docket No. G-2025-3056142

Dear Secretary Homsher:

Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. §2101 et. seq., Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or “Company”) filed for approval the confidential Affiliate Services Agreement (“ASA”) between The Efficient Network (“TEN”) and the Company on July 8, 2025. The subject agreement concerns selecting a professional energy consultant to provide customer-facing consulting services, technical guidance, engineering support, etc. to inform, develop, and execute new customer projects involving edge of the grid technologies (i.e., solar, battery storage, EV, etc.). The consultant would work directly with the customer on DLC's behalf and would also potentially arrange various types of financing structures to support these customer projects. In seeking this type of consultation, eight service providers were invited to participate. Of those eight, four submitted a formal bid. Two providers gave final presentations and after evaluation TEN was selected as the prevailing bidder.

Duquesne Light Company and TEN are both wholly owned subsidiaries of Duquesne Light Holdings. As a result of this relationship, the Agreement is subject to the Affiliated Interest Agreement provisions of the Public Utility Code. The enclosed Agreement is marked as CONFIDENTIAL ATTACHMENT A. Duquesne Light respectively request that Attachment A be treated as confidential and protected from public disclosure as it contains competitive information. The CONFIDENTIAL Version of this filing will be uploaded to the Commission’s SharePoint site.

The scope and cost of the bid was in the expected range for the services requested. Approval of the Agreement is in the public interest as TEN is highly qualified with direct experience completing similar projects for other entities. Duquesne is interested in moving forward with the contract, in order to obtain necessary services and provide benefits to customers. The Company requests that the Commission approve the Agreement as soon as is reasonably practicable

The Scope of Work between DLC and TEN is included in Schedule 1 (Scope of Work) of the ASA. As designed, the agreement will be used on an ad-hoc basis to provide individual customers with TEN’s consulting services. A specific statement of work will be generated and signed for each customer project as needed. Billing for the initial consulting will take place between TEN and DLC, and DLC will pass on the cost, including any DLC costs

incurred, to the individual customer. This will be billed to the customer as a Nonstandard Service under Rule 8 of DLC's approved Tariff. Further work beyond the initial statement of work will be negotiated between TEN and the customer directly (including payment), and DLC would no longer be involved. Other customers not involved with an individual contract will not pay any of the costs associated with this ASA.
