**Request for Extension of Comment Period**

Dear Secretary Homsher,

On December 22, 2025, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter in the above-noted proceeding requiring UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI) to file a revised projected needs assessment within fifteen days from the date of that Letter. UGI subsequently requested a 10-day extension, which was granted by the Commission, and timely filed its revised needs assessment on January 16, 2026. Pursuant to the December 22 Secretarial Letter, comments responding to UGI's revised needs assessment are to be filed within 10 days of the Company's filing, or January 29, 2026.

The Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) respectfully requests a 10-day extension of the comment period, which if granted would require that comments be filed by Friday, February 6, 2026.

Counsel for CAUSE-PA has numerous competing litigation schedules at this time, as such, an additional 10 days would provide CAUSE-PA sufficient time to adequately review and respond to UGI's revised needs assessment. We further believe that this extension would not prejudice any party – nor would it substantially impact the timeline for a final decision in this proceeding.

CAUSE-PA consulted with the other parties to this case in advance of filing this request, and it is our understanding that OCA does not oppose this request. Other parties, including the Company, have not responded to our inquiry at the time of this filing.

We appreciate the Commission's consideration of this request.
