Request for Information

Questions for evaluation on a PUC Application require regulation compliant answers, they should be well thought out and complete, and must answer all parts of the questions asked. Please review Title 52 PA Code to ensure your answers meet that standard.

- 1.) First and foremost, PUC Authority does not include crossing state lines. The PUC jurisdiction is for point to point transportation within Pennsylvania. If you intend to cross state lines, you would need to add authority through the US Dept of Transportation / FMCSA.
- 2.) Territory will not be allocated to any company with one vehicle. You should review the application. Territory is typically granted by authority to originate trips within specific counties, and can be written to be able to go from those originating counties to anywhere else in the state and return. If you have specific questions, call 717-214-7155 for clarification.
- 3.) Note that when you mention the transportation of persons whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating vehicles, that means you can only transport persons with such religious convictions, typically Amish, Mennonite or similar.
- 4.) Despite the fact that you have stated Mr. Milchak will be the only driver, there must be a plan in place in case you were ever to hire another. Note that you must read Title 52 and supply a compliant answer to the questions in Question 5 of the Verified Statements, and the answers must meet frequency of record checks as well as retention of those records, as set out in the Title.

- 5.) The Statement of Financial Position must be dated, and must show enough assets to pay ongoing insurance requirements as well as show reserves for repairs and daily business operations. The statement filed with this application is insufficient to operate a business, so now is the time to make sure the LLC has been funded to operate.

The purpose of the verified statement questions is to determine your ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. Failure to do so is sufficient grounds to justify the denial of your application because you have failed to provide sufficient evidence of your fitness to operate. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.
