**Please find attached Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 6, effective March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026 (this tariff cancels Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 5), for Keystone Moving Systems, Inc. d/b/a Nicky's Moving & Storage (PA PUC Certificate #A-00114293), 7660 Queen Street, Wyndmoor PA 19038.**

Changes to this tariff are an **INCREASE** in container rates, an **INCREASE** in handling charges for specific bulky items as noted in Item 200, an **INCREASE** in local hourly rates (both Non-Peak Season and Peak Season) for all time periods, an **INCREASE** in the overnight holding fee and truck occupancy charge, and a **CHANGE** in the application of the travel time charge.



SECTION 1  
RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY**

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

**ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

**ITEM 40 - PACKING AND UNPACKING SERVICE**

Packing/unpacking labor, when requested by the shipper, will be performed using the hourly labor rates shown in Section 3, Item 300. The total charges for packing/unpacking services will be based on the cost of containers and other packing materials supplied by the carrier plus all applicable labor fees subject to two hours minimum.

**ITEM 200 - ADDITIONAL SERVICES**

◆ The following charges will apply in addition to applicable hourly rates for specific bulky items on shipments transported forty (40) miles or less:  
Upright Pianos/Organs - \$225.00 per item; Safes - \$90.00 per item; Fish Tank - \$90.00 per item; Riding Lawnmower - \$90.00 per item; and Canoe/Small Boat - \$90.00

SECTION 3  
HOURLY RATES

**ITEM 300 - HOURLY RATES**

Applicable on the transportation of shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances of forty (40) miles or less.

Subject to Notes 1 to 7 below, the transportation charge on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

The hourly rates begins when the moving vehicle and crew arrive at the point of origin contracted for the move and ends when all the goods are unloaded at the final destination less any scheduled breaks and/or vehicle breakdowns plus the applicable travel time (see NOTE 6 below).

Traveling charges cover traveling from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and traveling from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal irrespective of the actual time involved in such traveling.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour considered as one-half hour.

NOTE 4 - Overtime hourly rates of time and a half apply after eight (8) hours of labor Monday-Sunday.

NOTE 5 - When requested or required, the cost for Overnight Holding Fee is **\$275.00** per truck per night (no to exceed one night). The additional cost for Truck Occupancy is **\$50.00** per hour (subject to four hours minimum - not to exceed five hours or Overnight Holding Fee will apply in addition to the initial five hours).

NOTE 6 - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal.

▲ **Governing References:** Carrier's Client Management System (CMS), move management software, will be utilized to track all mileage from the first point of origin to the final destination and for travel time charges.

0 - 40 miles                      1 hour

41 - 80 miles                      2 hours

For mileage in excess of 80 miles, a travel time charge of 1 hour will be assessed for each additional 40 miles.

NOTE 7 - When requested or required, carrier will provide a supervisor(s). The rate for a supervisor will be the Additional Unit Rate plus **\$7.00**. The hours for the supervisor(s) will be computed based on arrival of the supervisor(s) at the point of origin until completion of the move at the final destination and departure of the supervisor(s) plus the applicable travel time charge.

## TRANSPORTATION RATES

Applicable for shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported in excess of forty (40) miles.

**ITEM 400 - INTRASTATE TRANSPORTATION RATES**

Rates are in dollars and cents per 100 pounds applied to the actual weight and include loading & unloading of the shipment and the actual movement or transportation of the property from the origin to the final destination.
