Dear Parties:

On January 27, 2026, Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC) filed a Letter Request seeking a 30-day extension to file a response to Mr. Hofrichter's Formal Complaint. The original response is due on or before February 5, 2026. In its Letter Request, PAWC averred that it needed additional time to complete its fact-finding process as it relates to the claims made in the Formal Complaint. PAWC also averred that the parties are actively seeking a non-adjudicative resolution to the case and that, in order to facilitate the pending settlement discussions, an extension is necessary. It should also be noted that PAWC indicated in its Letter Request that the Complainant does not object to the extension.
