To whom it may concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application for **Paratransit** authority at Docket No. A-2025-3059327 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience shall not be granted for the following reason(s):

- **Failure to establish financial fitness to operate.** Under 52 Pa. Code §41.14(1) The Commission is to determine whether an applicant possesses the technical and financial ability to provide the proposed service. On January 5, 2026, the applicant provided additional financial records for the Commission's review. In that filing there was a response stating that the applicant's business accounts had available cash balance of \$567.97. They also included a quote for twelve months of commercial motor vehicles insurance at a total premium of \$11,700, or approximately \$975 a month. In addition to the cash balance and costs of insurance, the applicant listed one vehicle as part of the assets held by the LLC, a 2014 Ford Explorer with approximately 145,000 miles. Even when considering the applicant's financial situation in the most favorable light, the lack of cash assets or other tangible assets present a picture where the applicant lacks suitable finances to even pay for one month of insurance premiums, let alone ensure proper maintenance of said vehicle should the need arise. This represents a clear inability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable service.

For this reason(s), your application is **DENIED** and **DISMISSED**.

**APPEAL RIGHTS**

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

**ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission are advised to open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by mail. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be mail.**

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:
